and musical theatre to world-renowned dance with the likes of the historic Martha Graham Dance Company (NYC), A Noise Within Classical Repertory Theatre (Los Angeles) and TexARTS (Austin) which he founded along with Broadway performer Robin Lewis and where the duo produced Broadway Series productions at Austin's historic Paramount as well as Off-Broadway and Youth Series productions in the Capitol Lake Region theatre which they built. In these roles, he's produced international and national tours, New York and Los Angeles seasons, directed and taught various professionals and young people, and raised over \$20M in support of arts and culture over his 20-plus years before joining Rider. Prior, Dellinger was a professional (AEA, SAG/AFTRA) performer on stage and in film & television.




